



Notice of Procedural Change - Insurance

To All Members and Leagues:

Roller Sports Canada plans to continue its long-standing support of providing additional and supplementary insurance for its members. Having insurance in sports such as the ones we partake in is a necessity, and having a quick response when an injury occurs is paramount.

As you may be aware, the issue of insurance claims has become a serious one for all teams due to the growing number of injuries during practices and competitions. As our sports grow and gain popularity, these will continue to increase. In the past year alone, we have seen a 40% increase in claims across all disciplines.

As always, the procedure for handling expenses for medical treatment due to injuries suffered while voluntarily participating in an RSC sanctioned recreational activity should be the same as handling other injuries—members should submit expenses for reimbursement through their medical benefits plans just as they would for any other illness or injury. Any costs not covered by provincial/company/private plans can then be submitted to RSC.

We have made one change: Effective April 15, 2015, Roller Sports Canada is requiring all members to submit all claims to **Adam Levens, Director of Risk Management** (rscadam@gmail.com), prior to submission to Pearson Dunn. Adam will ensure that coordination of benefits occurs, that all options have been utilized to the fullest and will work with the injured member and Pearson Dunn to provide a quick and efficient turnaround of all claims.
