RSC's Speed Committee remains committed to building a sustainable structure for long-term-growth for RSC Speed and the sport of roller and inline speed skating in Canada.

Important tasks the Speed Committee worked on include an update to the "RSC Speed Committee- Rules and Regulations". This document guides the election and operation for RSC Speed.

The RSC Speed Committee also had an in-depth revision of the "Rules for RSC Speed". Many of the updates were put in place after considering feedback from a survey from participants of the 2013 Canadian Championships and also feedback from TISC; last year's host of the Canadian Championships.

As a result of much work, the "Rules for RSC Speed" were published and distributed in March 2013 and once again in 2014.

The update to the "Rules for RSC Speed" include a number of revisions, including an update on how the Open Category operates. The Open Category allows for skaters of various categories to compete together.

Another important change is the adoption of the points system used in previous RSC Rulebooks.

The Rules for RSC Speed now feature a section detailing various infractions.
